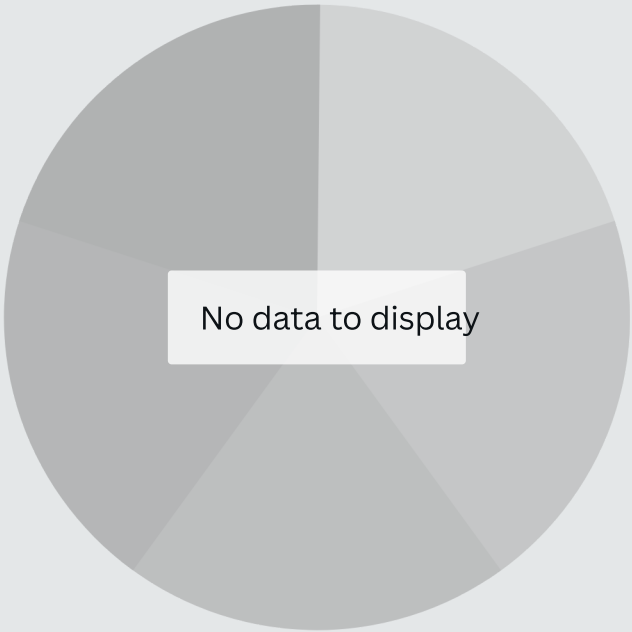
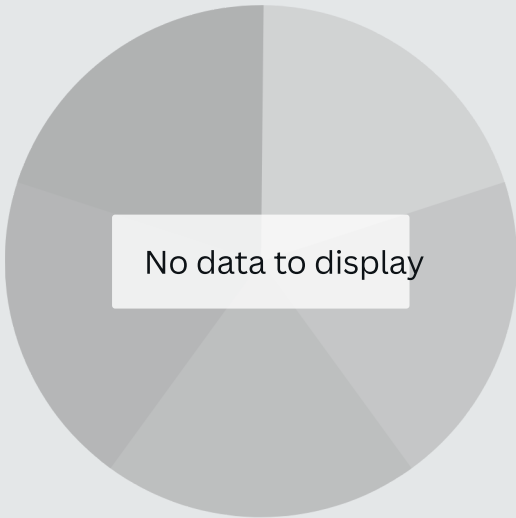


Do you prefer to learn outdoor than indoor?



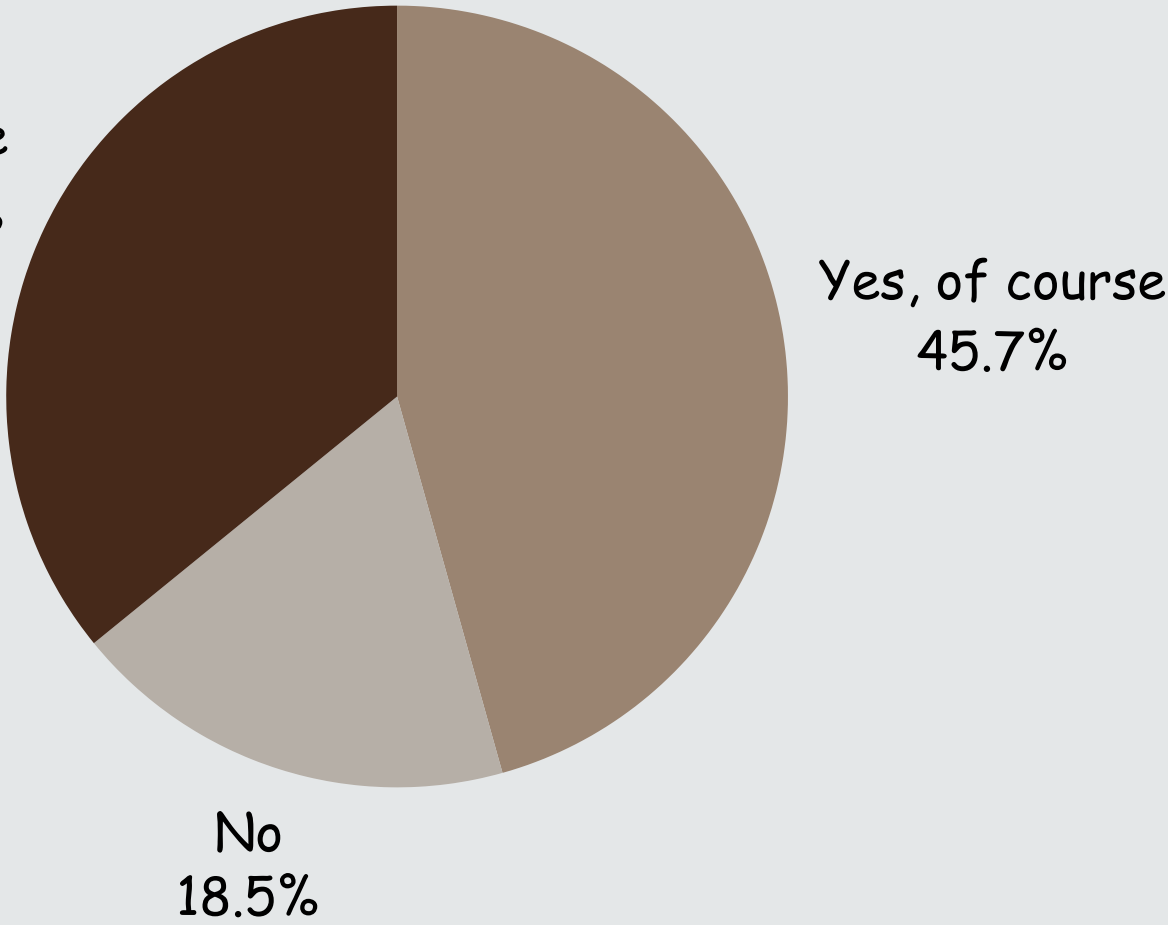

Education allow students to analyze information, solve problems, and think critically. The program is often well-defined, and students follow a set schedule. It can create a sense of order and routine. ☆

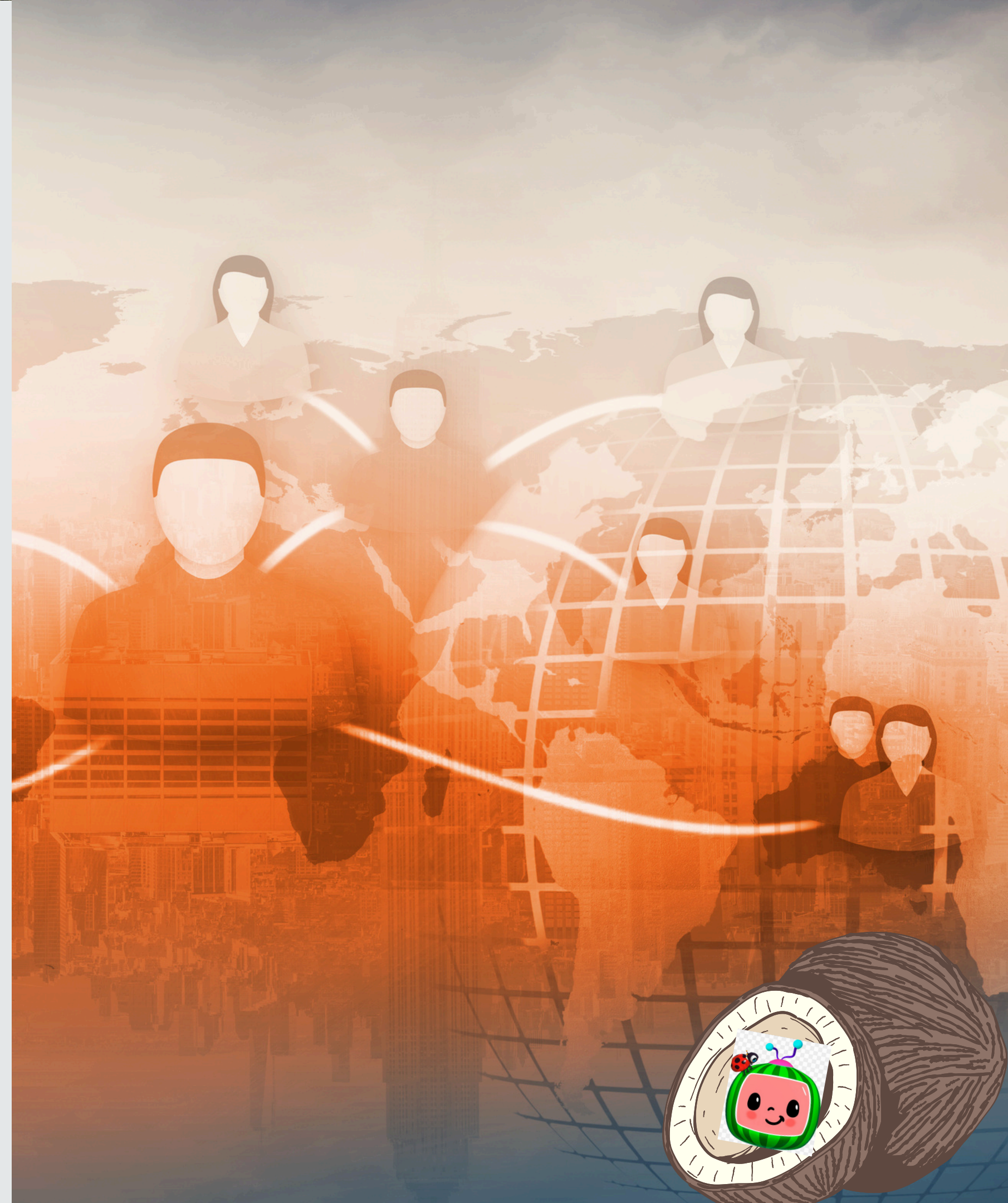

Cons of traditional school learning

Cons of extracurricular club





Some solutions for our school

- More Outdoor Spaces: Create more gardens or playgrounds where students can relax and play.
- After-School Clubs: Start new clubs based on interests like art, sports, or science to engage students
- Student Suggestion Box: Set up a box where students can share their ideas and opinion

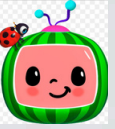
