	Remember the Milk. Get organised: Makes lists of tasks to do; reminds you of deadlines, allows you to share the tasks with others (who can remind you too). 	Just Press Record. Record what you or others are saying; Play it back straight from your phone; get the recording turned into text straight away...and copy it into any document you're using  only £			Otter AI. 	Seeing AI. Using the camera - Have printed text read out loud to you (and ask questions about the contents), Read out products from their barcodes, Recognise people, Describe surroundings, Recognise banknotes, Read out and save handwritten documents, Have colours and light levels identified			Envision lets you take a photo of a document - eg a PowerPoint and you can then ask questions about the content...and it will answer them.	
	Copilot is like a super-smart writing buddy that helps you improve your text in real-time. It's kind of like having an AI sidekick for your essays and creative writing! (written by Copilot) You can also create images.			Chat GPT is an AI chatbot that researches and creates answers to questions you give it, in the format you want.	
	Photomath. Uses your phone's camera to answer maths questions and equations (and see the workings-out) using AI.			Microsoft Lens. Take a photograph of a document, spreadsheet, whiteboard or computer screen, have it read out loud to you, send it into another document and be able to edit it.	
	Socratic. Type, say or photograph a question and Socratic will answer it, using AI – and give you links to sources.			White Noise Lite. Use your earbuds or headphones to block out noise and listen to relaxing sounds to help you to focus.	
	Goblin Tools Uses AI to break tasks down, to estimate how long a task will take, turn random ideas into a "to do" list, to change the style of your written work, ...and more.			Plantie is a stylish activity timer that helps you stay focused while you work or revise - and rewards you by helping your virtual plant to grow!	
	Brainscape. Flashcards for when you seriously want to learn things - no quizzes! On-line flashcards that you can make yourself - or use preloaded packs.			Use Clear Todos to make colourful, eye-catching, simple lists that can be changed by swiping and dragging and with alarms to remind you of deadlines.	
	XMind. Make mindmaps of your ideas on your phone. Add notes or videos. Print or send them to others and use them for planning and revision.			Time Timer. Helps you organise your time- multiple visual timers with alarms that you can personalise
